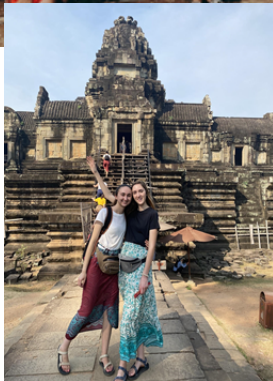


# STUDY ABROAD for NURSING STUDENTS



## Nursing Student Program Options

### Semester:

Requires planning during the first semester of freshman year to not delay admission to the Nursing Program. You will need to study abroad during the first semester of sophomore year if you wish to study for an entire semester. \*Applications are due in January of your freshman year.

### Short-term Faculty-Led Programs:

You have the option to take courses designed by Edgewood faculty that include a travel component, usually structured as a Fall course with Winter Travel, or Spring course with Summer Travel.

### Summer:

You can study abroad any time during the summer term over the course of your academic career. Summer programs include both individual and faculty-led programs.

*\*All programs are available before acceptance into the Nursing Program.*

*\*After starting the Nursing Program, students can only study on faculty-led or summer study abroad programs.*
