## Common Study Abroad Questions:

✓ ***When should business students study abroad?***

The Business Department recommends students study abroad either second semester junior year or first semester senior year. You are not limited to these terms, but if you wish to study abroad any other term it may delay graduation.

✓ ***What is the difference between an exchange program and a non-Edgewood program?***

**Exchange Programs-** Typically students pay Edgewood College tuition, room and board (rate of Stevie dormitory) plus exchange student fee \$550. \*You can apply all Edgewood and Federal scholarships and grants towards your program. Exchange programs are recommended for students who largely rely on institutional aid for funding.

**Non-Edgewood Programs-**students pay provider directly for the cost of the program. Typically includes tuition, international health insurance and accommodations. \*Only federal aid applies! These programs are recommended for students who are paying more out of pocket to attend Edgewood.

✓ ***Are there scholarships available for study abroad?***

Yes! All students have access to Edgewood College study abroad scholarships. Typical awards range from \$500-\$1,000. Students also have options for scholarships through their providers and universities abroad.

*Example: Karlsruhe University of Applied Sciences offers a 2,000 EURO scholarship every spring semester.*

✓ ***What other outside costs will I have with studying abroad?***

Additional expenses (outside of tuition, room and board) typically include: airfare, visa (very important for students studying over 90 days or interning), international health insurance, books and personal expenses. \*Costs differ based on program package and host country.

✓ ***What type of academic credit can I get?***

Business students can fulfill major, minor and general education requirements abroad. If you have a focus to your business degree such as marketing, it is important to prioritize those courses abroad in combination with general education coursework. Many students take 12-15 credits while abroad for a semester. All international internship courses are worth 6 credits and may count toward the internship major requirement. Through the advising process students will work with their Study Abroad Advisor, Academic Advisor and the Registrar Office to determine Edgewood course equivalences and academic appropriateness.

✓ ***Am I eligible to study abroad?***

GPA requirements vary by program. Students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA to apply for an Edgewood sponsored semester or academic year program. All internships require a 2.50 GPA and some short-term programs (faculty-led programs) and non-Edgewood sponsored programs (i.e. ISA and API) may have lower GPA requirements.
